2023-24 SHEPNAZ BASKETBALL 3rd GRADE BOYS LEAGUE RULES 3rd & 4th GRADE GIRLS LEAGUE RULES

- 1. The 3rd grade boys' league and the 3^{rd} and 4^{th} girls' leagues will use a 9-foot basket.
- 2. The 3rd grade boys' league and the 3rd and 4th girls' leagues will use a 27.5" basketball.
- 3. The game will consist of six periods lasting six minutes each. The clock will be a running clock.
- 4. The scrimmage will be played in a "five-on-five" player format.
- 5. No substitutions should take place until the start of the next period except for injury or fatigue purposes.
- 6. Each player must start in at least three periods with the purpose to create balanced playing time for all players.
- 7. Games will not have referees. One coach from each team will be on the floor coaching and calling major violations.
- 8. Defense:
 - Man-to-Man defense only
 - No steals off the dribble are allowed; steals off the pass is allowed.
 - The defense may pick up their player at the half court line (blue lines in the Central Complex).
 - The defense must pick up their player at the three-point line or equivalent area.
 - No double-teaming or trapping defenses are permitted.
- 9. When the offensive team possesses the ball in the frontcourt and the ball goes out of bounds or a violation rewards the offensive team with the ball, the ball shall be taken out at the top of the key or equivalent area.
- 10. Each team must pass the ball at least once before a shot is attempted.
- 11. Double dribbling and traveling violations should be taught as a point of emphasis throughout the season. Coaches are to call all obvious violations on their own team and treat the violation as a turnover.
- 12. Fouls are to be called by either coach with the purpose of balancing a good flow of teaching the game with the prevention of injuries. No foul shots will be shot.
- 13. No timeouts shall be called. Any stoppage of play will not stop the running clock.
- 14. There is a 10-minute halftime.
- 15. There is no score kept in this league.
